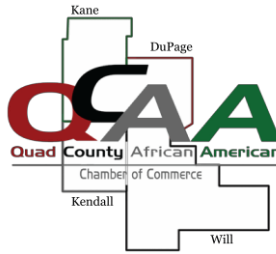

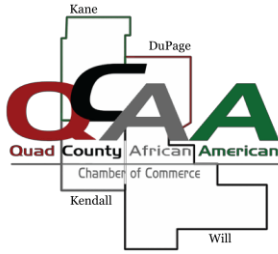
The following outlines the criteria for consideration:

- Applicants must attend an academic institution that is a member in good standing of the QCAACC, or reside in one of the Quad Counties.
- College Student with a minimum 3.0 G.P.A. on 4.0 scale
- Ethnicity of African American descent
- Pursuing a degree in Business, Science, Technology, Engineering or Math
- Complete, signed, and dated application including:
 - Copy of College transcript(s) (Official or Unofficial)
 - List of extra-curricular Activities (i.e. sports, student organizations, etc.)
 - 2 letters of reference
 - One reference from a faculty or staff member who can support your educational excellence and extra-curricular activities.
 - One reference from a community leader or employer who can support your work ethic or community service.
- Personal essay answering the question: "How you will use your education to advance the African American community"
(Minimum 500 words, maximum 5 pages – double spaced, 12 pt. font)

Scholarship applications and supporting materials must be postmarked no later than January 12, 2018 and mailed to our offices at 43 W. Galena, Aurora, IL 60506, or emailed to cobmqaac@yahoo.com

To ensure the integrity of the selection process, applicants must meet all requirements and **incomplete applications will not be considered**. Please note that materials submitted will not be returned.
